

## Documentation for Embedding Adobe Forms in Wordpress - Last Updated 11/6/17

Now that we're using JavaScript to pass along UTM from Wordpress to Adobe Campaign to GA, the iframe form code is a little different, but website visitors shouldn't see a difference between the javascript iframe forms and the old static forms. In the instances when a visitor does not have JavaScript enabled, the static iframe will display anyway.

Previously, the static iframe code (won't pass UTM parameters):

The javascript-containing iframe code (see next page for code for forms with sourceURL):

  iframe.setAttribute('type', 'text/html');  
  iframe.setAttribute('frameborder', 0);  
  iframe.setAttribute('scrolling', 'no');  
  iframe.setAttribute('allowTransparency', 'true');  
  iframe.style.border = '0';  
  thisScript.parentElement.replaceChild(iframe, thisScript);

Please replace the Adobe form URL with your new URL, **taking care to use the HTTPS link if your site is HTTPS certified**, and change the dimensions as needed. If you have a sourceURL for your webpage, or would like to add one to your iframe form, please use the code on the following page.

The sourceURL parameter is used when you're sharing a single Adobe form across webpages and would like to know where the form fill came from. In those instances, please replace **PLACEHOLDER** in the code below with a descriptive word or phrase, making sure to substitute '+' for any spaces (e.g. 'Email Marketing' → 'Email+Marketing'). And if you want the respondents to be tied to a particular Salesforce campaign, let the Advance Insights team know so we can update the workflows on our end.

The javascript iframe code, including sourceURLs (please update **PLACEHOLDER**):
